Medical supplies donated by the Government and people of the State of Israel and Nepali community residing in Israel including the Embassy of Nepal, Tel Aviv has been handed over to the Ministry of Health and Population of Nepal, jointly by Mr. Harishchandra Ghimire, Joint Secretary at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs on behalf of the Embassy of Nepal, Tel Aviv and H. E. Mr. Hanan Goder, Israeli Ambassador to Nepal at Tribhuvan International Airport today.

The items sent from Israel to Nepal through a medical cargo charter flight of Nepal Airlines include 58 ventilators, 120 Oxygen Concentrators, 6 Mobile Corona testing lab, more than 100 thousand KN95 Mask, 40000 PPEs, thousands of Thermometers, PCR and Antigen test kits, COVID-19 Medicines, Sanitizer, Wipes, Gowns, Gloves, Boot, Face shield, Head cover, Shoe cover and Hand sleeves among others.

Apart from the medical equipment, 11 screens were also donated by the Israeli company named Monday.com which is working to establish Smart COVID-19 Command Control Room in Corona Crisis Management Center (CCMC).

The Embassy of Nepal expresses sincere gratitude to the Government and friendly people of Israel and the Nepali people residing in Israel for their generous support that will certainly complement the ongoing efforts for prevention, treatment and control of the COVID-19 pandemic in Nepal.
